


QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER


What is the youth's and family's perspective on the current situation?






Are all of the Wraparound principles being followed?

What phase of Wraparound is the team in? Do I need to return to the previous phase to address anything new or that was missed?












Do I need any coaching in order to facilitate the Wraparound team meeting components, e.g. principles, phases, activities or paperwork?

Is my perspective on this situation being influenced by my own experiences, beliefs, values and positionalities?



SYSTEM BARRIERS



If all answers to the previous questions indicate everything within my control is going well or being addressed, the situation could be the result of a system barrier. This should be brought to the supervisor as a possible barrier to be submitted to the Practice Level Work Group.
